



In order to be considered for admission into the full credential program, you must complete the required online application(s) and submit **ALL** required supplemental documents to the Credential Office by the application deadline. Candidates must complete (or be in progress to complete) the prerequisite courses prior to applying to the Full Credential Program.

**Incomplete application packets WILL NOT be accepted.** Prior to applying, it is highly recommended applicants attend an information meeting to obtain program information and application requirements. Advising appointments with the Credential Services Office are available.

## UNIVERSITY APPLICATION\*

*\*Not required if currently enrolled as a post baccalaureate student admitted in the Prerequisite Credential Program at CSU Channel Islands. Students who are completing the prerequisites within their bachelor's degree need to complete a university application to apply as a graduate student for the full credential program.*

### **CSU Graduate Application**

Apply online at [calstate.edu/apply](http://calstate.edu/apply). Personal statement and references are not required. See Quadrant IV of the Cal State Apply application for instructions on how to complete the Credential section.

*Print out the confirmation page to submit with your program application packet.*

### **Application Fee of \$55**

Payable online at the time you submit your application. *Print and submit the confirmation receipt.*

### **Official Transcripts\***

One full set of official, sealed transcripts from **ALL** colleges and universities attended must be submitted to the Admissions Office in Sage Hall. **\*Former and current CSU Channel Islands students do not need to submit transcripts, unless additional courses were taken since last attendance at CI.**

### **Certificate of Clearance from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing\***

*\*Applicants must receive clearance **prior** to submitting application packet to the Credential Office. Other types of permits, including substitute teacher permits, will no longer be accepted starting with spring 2018 applications.*

**TB Clearance**

Submit copy of a negative result **OR** chest x-ray results taken within the last 4 years. Valid results must be on file for the duration of enrollment in the program. TB Risk Assessment Questionnaire is not accepted.

**Writing Sample**

Submit online with program application.

**Two Recommendation Forms**

One recommendation from a professional who can describe your work with children; such as principal, supervisor, or teacher. The second recommendation must be from the professor of your field observation class.

**Field Experience Verification Form (45 hours total)**

**US Constitution Requirement**

**Prerequisite Courses**

Must be completed or in progress.

**Minimum GPA Requirement**

GPA must be 2.75 in the last 60 semester units completed or 2.67 cumulative.

**Credential Program Interview**

Applicants must submit a complete credential program application packet by credential deadline in order to be invited to the mandatory group interview.
