

United States Constitution Requirement

The United States Constitution requirement can be met by one of the following:

COURSEWORK:

Completion of a two semester unit course on the provisions and principles of the Constitution of the United States taken at a regionally accredited community college, or a four-year college or university

- Submit a copy of the course description, indicate the college or university the class was taken at, and indicate the semester the course was completed. Turn it in with the credential application packet and the credential office will evaluate if the course meets the requirement.

EXAMINATION:

Passage of an approved examination covering the provisions and principles of the Constitution of the United States

- Submit applicable certification demonstrating successful completion of an examination
- AP Government or AP History credit is accepted if clearly documented on an official college transcript

CSU DEGREE:

A Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree awarded by a CSU campus

The Education Code states that the US Constitution requirement may be met by satisfactory completion of coursework covering the principles of the U.S. Constitution. The Commission has deemed that coursework for this requirement must be met by the grade of "C" or better or a pass, credit, or satisfactory grade received for the course in whichever manner the course is completed. The requirement may be an online course taken at a regionally accredited two or four-year college or university.
