

California Internship Teacher Preparation Programs

Internship programs allow individuals to complete their teacher preparation coursework concurrent with their first year or two in a paid teaching position. Cal State Channel Islands, School of Education's Teacher Internship Programs are approved by the CCTC (California Commission on Teacher Credentialing). CSUCI internships are cooperative teaching programs between CSUCI and an employing school district. Completion of an internship program results in the same credential as is earned through a traditional teacher preparation program.

University Internship Teaching Credentials are issued by CCTC to individuals who have enrolled in a university's internship program. These one- to two-year programs are designed to provide participants with classroom experience as teachers of record while they complete course work requirements for the preliminary teaching credential. The Internship Credential authorizes the holder to serve, under the supervision of CSUCI faculty and field supervisors, in the area or subject listed on the credential. CSUCI Internship program are offered in the following areas:

- Multiple Subject
- Multiple Subject with BCLAD (Spanish)
- Single Subject (Math, English, Science and Social Science)
- Education Specialist Level I Mild/Moderate
