Intern Program Requirements

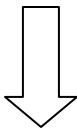
- B.A. or B.S. from a regionally-accredited college or university with a 2.75 GPA
- Passage of CBEST or other approved basic skills exam
- Verification of subject matter competency via coursework or exam
- Character and identification clearance
- U.S. constitution, via coursework or exam
- Offer of full-time employment with a participating Ventura County or Santa Barbara public school district in a teaching assignment which matches the credential being pursued
- Enrolled in Prerequisite or Credential Program.
- 120 Hours of Pre-Service Training

To be accepted into a university Intern credential program, potential interns must have 120 hours of pre-service training and must have the minimum requirements to teach English Learners (*This requirement is waived for regular education credentialed teachers obtaining an Education Specialist credential*). Our program has identified prerequisite courses that fulfill this requirement.

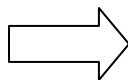

Ed Specialist candidates must also complete **SPED 345**



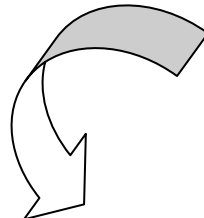
Application Process

- Contact Credential Analyst via email tina.torres@csuci.edu for forms and instructions
- Meet with Faculty advisor for academic plan
- Submit signed Intern Authorization form to Analyst in Credential Office
- Submit Intern application packet for processing to Analyst in Credential Office



Teacher Preparation

- Coursework blending theory and practice
- Continuous enrollment in 3 or more units of teacher credential courses each semester
- Ongoing advisement/meet with advisor each semester
- Ongoing on-site support and mentoring from university and school district
- Performance Assessment (*Single Subject and Multiple Subject Only*)
- Preparation for RICA (*Multiple Subject and Ed Specialist only*)
- CPR Certification (*Single Subject and Multiple Subject Only*)
- Intern Seminar (*Ed Specialist only*)
