Incomplete application packets WILL NOT be accepted. UNIVERSITY APPLICATION

CSU Graduate Application

Apply online at www.calstate.edu/apply. The personal statement and references are not required. See Quadrant IV of the Cal State Apply application for instructions on how to complete the Credential section.

Print out the confirmation page to submit with your program application packet.

Application Fee of \$55

Payable online at the time you submit your application. *Print and submit the confirmation receipt.*

Official Transcripts*

One full set of official, sealed transcripts from **ALL** colleges and universities attended must be submitted to the Admissions Office in Sage Hall. ***Former and current CSU Channel Islands students do not need to submit transcripts, unless additional courses were taken since last attendance at CI.**

Prerequisite Credential Program Application

Apply online at go.csuci.edu/soe.

Print out the confirmation page to submit with your program application packet.

Application Fee of \$25 (nonrefundable)

Payable online at the time you submit your application. *Print and submit the confirmation receipt.*

Minimum GPA Requirement

GPA must be 2.75 in the last 60 semester units completed or 2.67 cumulative.

Basic Skills Requirement

Submit a copy of a CBEST test date registration confirmation **OR** other applicable exam results.

Subject Matter Competency Requirement

Submit a copy of at least one CSET test date registration confirmation **OR** passing exam results **OR** an approved, original and signed Subject Matter Competency Waiver

Certificate of Clearance*

Submit a copy of clearance from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing website (www.etc.ca.gov).

*Applicants must receive clearance **prior** to submitting application packet to the Credential Office. (other types of permits (including substitute teacher permits) will no longer be accepted starting with Spring 2018 applications)*

TB Clearance

Submit copy of a negative result **OR** chest x-ray results taken within the last 4 years. Valid results must be on file for the duration of enrollment in the program. TB Risk Assessment Questionnaire is not accepted.
