

United States Constitution Requirement

The United States Constitution requirement can be met by one of the following:

COURSEWORK:

Completion of a two semester unit course on the provisions and principles of the Constitution of the United States taken at a regionally accredited community college, or a four-year college or university with a grade of “C” or better.

- Submit a copy of the course description, indicate the college or university the class was taken at, and indicate the semester the course was completed.

EXAMINATION:

Passage of an approved examination covering the provisions and principles of the Constitution of the United States.

- Submit applicable certification demonstrating successful completion of an examination
 - AP U.S Government or AP U.S. History credit is accepted if documented on the official transcript and given credits/units at the institution.
 - Notre Dame de Namur offers a fee based online examination and preparation materials. A certificate of completion is printable after passing the exam: www.usconstitutionexam.com

CSU DEGREE:

CSU graduates are required to complete a course that covers the Constitution as a degree requirement and typically meet this requirement through this pathway.

- For credentialing purposes, a grade of C or better must be earned in the applicable class.
