

## Dear Credential Program Students:

Welcome to the week of April 20<sup>th</sup>, the 4<sup>th</sup> week of virtual instruction at CI, and the 12<sup>th</sup> week of the spring 2020 semester. We hope you and your families are well and are adjusting and settling into some kind of a routine that includes self-care.

University faculty, staff, and administrators have been working on supporting you, our students, in a variety of ways during this pandemic. One of the most recent efforts includes passage of Academic Senate Resolution SR19-02: Continuity and Compassion Amid Disruption by COVID-19: Student Assessment for Spring 2020. The important take-aways from this resolution, that has been signed by University President Beck are:

- Students may opt to change their letter grade to a grade of Credit/No Credit (CR/NC); Although SR 19-02 states a grade of C- and better for Credit, credential program courses require a C+ for Credit and pre-requisite courses require a C for credit.
- Students may change their grading system in myCl starting April 21st through May 15th. A petition process is available from May 29-June 9 if a student feels they made the wrong choice. Students can petition back to letter grades during this time as well.
- Students may withdraw from any course as late as May 29th, 2020 with no signatures or outside documentation to support the withdrawal.
- Students normally subject to disqualification will be allowed to continue on probation for an additional semester.

Also note, grades of CR/NC are not calculated into the GPA. There is a petition process through the beginning of June if you want to change your grading option back or choose the CR/NC after seeing your grades.
