BILINGUAL AUTHORIZATION

Bilingual Authorization can be added to an <u>Elementary</u> Multiple Subject), <u>Secondary</u> (Single Subject), or <u>Education Specialist</u> (Special Education) Credential Program.

Placements are tailored to mirror the types of program models in Ventura County (Dual, transitional, or structured ELD; including our own UPCS charter school in Camarillo.

Completers of the Authorization provide instruction in dual Language (Spanish-English) classrooms, bilingual transitional classrooms, or a structured English immersion program.



Courses are taught in Spanish and English and opportunities to participate in dual language professional development are provided and encouraged.

BILINGUAL AUTHORIZATION



The Spanish Bilingual Authorization pathway prepares teachers to work in bilingual classrooms, dual language classrooms, English language development classrooms, content-area single subject classrooms and special education classrooms where Spanish language is used for instruction. The Bilingual Authorization may be added to a multiple subject, single subject, or education specialist credential by completing required paperwork.

CSET SPANISH III

Students who wish to complete the Spanish Bilingual Authorization must pass the CSET Spanish Subtest III assessment prior to student teaching in a bilingual classroom.

STUDENT TEACHING (in a bilingual classroom)

Program maintenance requirements: students must maintain a GPA of 3.0 (B) or better, with no course grades lower than a C+.
