



## Dual Licensure (Education Specialist + Multiple Subject) Pathway

- All Phase I (prerequisites) coursework must be passed with a C or better and must be completed prior to starting in Phase II (methods). Phase I (prerequisites) may be taken throughout the year as desired.
- All Phase II (methods) coursework must be passed with a grade of a C+ or better and with an overall min 3.0 GPA. All Phase II (methods) coursework must begin in the fall.
- Please see the education specialist credential counselor to plan your course of study. This is a suggested timeline and some pathways may vary.
