The Secondary Education Teaching Credential is for you!

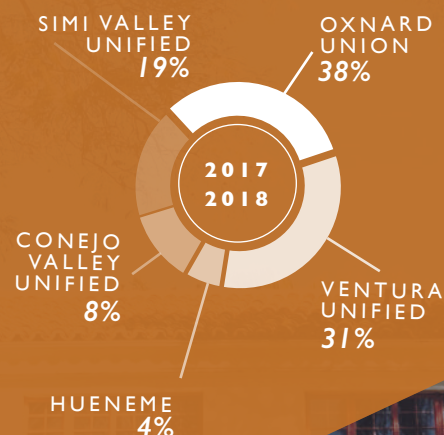
